The Holodomor is included in curricula on
human rights, genocide, history and social
justice in many parts of Canada, and is
one of nine genocides formally recognized
by the Government of Canada.

2022 HREC EDUCATOR AWARD FOR HOLODOMOR LESSON PLAN DEVELOPMENT

The HREC Educator Award for Holodomor
Lesson Plan Development is awarded
annually by HREC, a project of the Canadian
Institute of Ukrainian Studies, University
of Alberta. The award is intended to foster
the development of innovative, creative
and interactive lessons for grades K-12
that develop critical thinking skills while
addressing the topic of the Holodomor,
and to recognize the outstanding
educators who create them.

Individual awards will vary up to but not exceeding \$2,000 CDN based on the quality of submissions. The winning lesson plans will be posted on the HREC Education website and their authors will be acknowledged. Honourable Mention may also be accorded to lesson plans that will not be posted.
